171st SESSION OF THE MINNESOTA ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF THE UMC



JUNE 11-13, 2025 at the St. Cloud Convention Center in St. Cloud. Drawing from 1 John 4:7-21, the theme of the conference will be "Created for Love." We gather annually to be reminded what it means to be named and claimed by Jesus for the sake of our mission. This year, we will be reminded that we are created by love and for love. We will explore how to live together, anchored in our identity as Christ followers who are inspired to live with hope, possibility, and purpose.

Together, we determine mission priorities, commission and ordain ministers, hear challenges to grow in faith and witness, conduct the business necessary for an organization to function, and celebrate how we have brought God's love to others in Minnesota and around the world.

2025 LOVE OFFERING: Each year, churches in the Minnesota Annual Conference take a Love Offering for missions in conjunction with our Annual Conference Session.

The theme of the 2025 Annual Conference—which will take place June 11-13, 2025 at the St. Cloud Convention Center—is "Created for Love."



Our Love Offering theme this year is "Love in Action." Bishop Lanette Plambeck invites congregations to pray about and participate in the Love Offering as we put love into action. Donations to the 2024 Love Offering totaled **\$142,963.40**, a 78 percent increase from the 2023 total! How much will we raise this year?

This year's Love Offering will go to:

- Africa University for student scholarships (30%)
- Immigration Law and Justice Network (30%)
- OC Ministries (20%)
- Midwest Mission (20%)

We will also collect supplies and kits for Midwest Mission and United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR).
